Conditions of Postal Sale

The CMS reserves the right to refuse items which are damaged or unsuitable, or we have doubts about authenticity.

Reserves can be placed on lots but must be agreed with the CMS. They should reflect realistic values/expectations and not be the "highest price" expected.

The CMS will take 7% of the price realised, the vendor 93% which will normally be paid no later than 6 weeks after the auction.

The CMS will undertake to advertise the memorabilia for auction on its website no later than 3 weeks prior to the closing date of the auction. Bids will only be accepted from CMS members.

Postal bids must be <u>in writing or e-mail</u> by the closing date and time shown above. Generally, no item will be sold below 10% of the lower estimate without reference to the vendor. Thus, an item with a \pounds 10-15 estimate can be sold for \pounds 9, but not \pounds 8, without approval.

The incremental scale for the acceptance of bids is as follows: £2 increments up to £20, then $\pounds 20/22/25/28/30$ up to £50, then £5 increments to £100 and £10 increments above that. So, if there are two postal bids at £25 and £30, the item will go to the higher bidder at £28. Should there be two identical bids, the first received will win. Bids submitted between increments will be accepted, thus a £52 bid will not be rounded either up or down.

Items will be sent to successful postal bidders within 3 weeks of the auction and will be sent by the cheapest rate commensurate with the value and size of the item. Postage and packaging will be paid by the successful postal bidder. Successful bidders should aim to pay quickly, so that accounts with vendors can be settled.

The CMS will be responsible for the items sent for auction while they are in the possession of the CMS.

A list of prices realised at an auction will be published on the Society's website.

Remember - it is the only cricket auction with no buyer's premium – and postage is charged at cost!
