Conditions of Sale

The CMS welcomes items of cricket memorabilia for its auctions. There will normally be just two room auctions in the year - March and October, with a postal auction in July.

The CMS reserves the right to refuse items which are damaged etc., or we have doubts about authenticity.

Reserves can be placed on lots but must be agreed with the CMS. They should reflect realistic values/expectations and not be the "highest price" expected.

The CMS will take 7% of the price realised, the vendor 93% which will normally be paid 6 weeks after the auction.

The CMS will undertake to advertise the memorabilia to all its members (including overseas) and only CMS members are eligible to bid for items.

Members are welcome to send postal bids which should be <u>in writing/e-mail</u> before the auction. Bids will normally start at 60% of the lower estimate unless there is a higher reserve price or other postal bids. Any bids submitted with pence, ie. £5.20 or £5.80, will automatically be rounded up.

Items will be sent to successful postal bidders after the auction and will usually be sent by recorded delivery. Postage will be paid by the successful postal bidder. However, framed and glazed items must be collected at an auction or arrangements made for collection unless the buyer is content for items to be sent without insurance cover, as the CMS is unable to obtain insurance for such items.

The CMS will be responsible for the items sent for auction while they are in the possession of the CMS.

The CMS welcomes items of particular and unusual interest for the auctions. Non-members can send items for auction but we would discourage large quantities of books, magazines etc.

A list of prices realised at an auction will be displayed on the Society's website after the auction.

Remember - it is the only cricket auction with no buyers premium!

Jessop played only two 1st class matches for Hampshire. *Newman* was involved in an incident at Trent Bridge when he refused to bowl while the crowd were barracking. Tennyson ordered him from the field. *Arnold* was a double international – cricket and football.

Arnold was a double international – cricket and football. H D G Leveson-Gower was one of **Frederick**'s brothers. **Shirley's** Hampshire debut was in the match v Warwickshire when Hampshire were bowled out for 15 but went on to win the match. Shirley scored 1 of the 15.

Bill Buck remains the only cricketer to play against two different touring teams in the same season, for two different counties. The first was for Somerset v West Indies, the second Hampshire v New Zealand. These were his only 1st class matches. **Greig's** cricket career began in 1893 in India whilst stationed there with the British Army. In 1898 he scored the first double century in 1st class cricket on Indian soil. **Sir Francis Lacey** was secretary of the MCC from 1898-1926. He was knighted in 1926 for his services to sport and was the first person to be

knighted for services to any sport. **Taylor** made one appearance in 1935, his other appearances being in 1939 when he was captain for part of the season.

Harrison was also a footballer who played for Crystal Palace, Southampton and Exeter City. *Sean Morris* was chief executive of the PCA in 2008 before joining Rajasthan Royals in 2009 as their chief executive. *Steele's* career with Hampshire actually began in 1886 but, at that time, the county had lost its first class status.

Percy MacKenzie played 22 1st class matches for Hampshire between 1938 and 1939. In May 1942, he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross. In January 1943, he successfully piloted a damaged Lancaster bomber back to England following a raid over Berlin. For this action,

Alec Debnam played eleven 1st class matches for Hampshire in 1950 and 1951. He served in the RAF during the War and was recommissioned in 1952, ending his service in 1964.

32. Richard Edward Hayward autograph on an A4 sheet with the county banner to the top, player's name in bold and a box below containing his signature. Included is a typewritten letter, signed 'Richard' on Nelson Cricket Academy notepaper. Excellent Est. £10/12

Richard Hayward made thirteen 1st class appearances for Hampshire between 1981 and 1982. He played Minor Counties cricket for Buckinghamshire either side of his time with Hampshire, finishing in 1989. He also played in New Zealand during the English winter. In 2002, he was appointed as Canterbury's Director of Coaching and Development. He is also a match referee for New Zealand Cricket. In November 2019 he was made a life member of the Central Districts Cricket Association.

33. Linden Anthony Joseph autograph on an A4 sheet with the county banner to the top, player's name in bold and a box below containing his signature. Included is hand written letter, signed in block capitals and the Air Mail envelope in which it arrived from Guyana. Excellent Est. £8/12

Linden Joseph played six 1st class matches for Hampshire in 1990, having been recommended by Malcolm Marshall. He made his 1st class debut in 1988 in Guyana and continued to represent Guyana until 1995. Although he did not return to county cricket, he played for Enfield in the Lancashire League in 1991 and 1992.

34. John Errol Manners autograph on an A4 sheet with the county banner to the top, player's name in bold and a box below containing his signature. Included is a hand written letter, signed by him. Excellent Est. £10/12

It is not clear precisely how many 1st class appearances Manners made for Hampshire between 1936 and 1948 but nine appears to be thereabouts. However his service in the Navy is worth reading. As a précis he served in the Second World War and held several commands, earning the Distinguished Service Cross for his role in the sinking of the German submarine U-1274 in April 1945 while commanding the destroyer HMS Viceroy. But there is much, much more to his record.

Hughie Webb only played one 1st class match for Hampshire in 1954, his other 1st class appearance having been for Oxford University. During the summer term of his final year at Winchester, Field Marshal Montgomery came to visit his son, where he was impressed by Webb's captaincy of the college cricket team in their match against Eton College. As a result, he was invited by Montgomery to accompany his son on a visit to his headquarters in the British occupation zone in Germany. He was a pioneering and internationally renowned professor of neurovirology at St Thomas's Hospital in London.
